

Castilla y León Privileged geographical position

Castilla y León is located in the centre of Spain, it has 95,000 km2 (23,475,011 acres) of territory and around 2,600,000 inhabitants. Castilla y León is the largest region in Spain and the second largest one in Europe.

It shares a border with 9 other Spanish regions and with Portugal.

It is a strategic area for trade between Europe and the rest of the world, as it is situated on the Helsinki-Lisbon axis and the link between Portugal and the rest of Europe.



Castilla y León Strategic geographical location



According to the United Nations Human Development Index, Castilla y León is among the regions with the highest quality of life. The region has the highest public safety level in Spain.

Seven places in Castilla y León have been designated by the UNESCO as World Heritage sites: Ávila, Salamanca, Segovia, Las Médulas (León), the Burgos cathedral and the Atapuerca (Burgos) archaeological site, as well as the Pilgrim's route to Santiago.
